Your tour begins at Te Ana Māori Rock Art Centre, where our Ngāi Tahu guides share stories of our ancestors and our rich tribal culture, past and present.

The Centre holds the most significant collection of Māori rock drawings in the world and is an entranceway into the world of Ngāi Tahu, the Māori tribe of Te Waipounamu (the South Island) of New Zealand.

Continue your journey at the iconic rock art sites at Ōpihi. You will discover Māori rock art where it was created and gain a deeper understanding of our ancestors and why their artworks are such a cherished part of Ngāi Tahu identity today. Contribute to the restoration of the site by planting a native tree as a legacy of your visit.
